What types of students attend PBA?

All types of students attend our school. Our students come from home schools, private schools, public schools and boarding schools.

Our Secondary program at Palmetto Bay Academy supports learners in grades 6-12. Most of our students are above average in intelligence and come from professional families. Some have specific learning differences and some are just looking for a different educational experience in a small, nurturing but college preparatory environment.

Our Primary program T.A.P.P., which opened in the Fall of 2024, is a boutique, small-school environment specializing in Twice-Exceptional / 2e learners who are Bright or Gifted with learning differences or other exceptionalities, including Profoundly Gifted children, who can benefit by accessing personalized learning while still in a warm, caring and joyous school environment.

What unifies our students and their families is their wish to achieve their personal best.

Additional Program Information

We have Primary (Grades 1-6) in our Toucanet Academy for Passionate Pursuits program, or TAPP for short. This program was developed to serve Gifted/Bright but struggling students, 2e learners, learners of above average intelligence or creativity who may be struggling with emotional control challenges, ADHD, ASD, Dyslexia, Anxiety, or be Profoundly Gifted, etc.

We have Secondary (grades 6-12) in our Academy program. In our Academy program we support all levels of instruction from remedial to Advanced Placement while helping young

people learn the tools and techniques that best support their own unique mind. Students may also take advantage of Dual Enrollment through MDC & FIU, Jacksonville University and, our newest partner Arizona State University. Students should speak with the Director if they wish to be considered for AP and Dual Enrollment programs.
